HEAR THE WORD OF GOD

- **ROM 10:17 - Faith comes by hearing**
- **ROM 1:16 - Gospel is the power of God unto salvation**
- **There is no other way to know what God wants us to do**

(Rom 10:17 KJV) "So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

(Rom 1:16 KJV) "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek."

BELIEVE

- **JN 8:24 - Believe not, die in your sins**
- **ROM 10:13-14,17 - Progressive steps**
- **HEB 11:6 - Cannot please God without faith**
- **JAS 2:24 - Not by faith only**
- **JAS 2:19 - Even the devils believe**

(John 8:24 KJV) "I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am *he*, ye shall die in your sins."

(Rom 10:13-14 KJV) "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. {14} How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?"

(Rom 10:17 KJV) "So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

(Heb 11:6 KJV) "But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."

(James 2:24 KJV) "Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only."

(James 2:19 KJV) "Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble."

REPENT

- **INVOLVES A CHANGE OF MIND AND WILL**
- **LK 13:3 - Repent or perish**
- **ACTS 17:30 - Commands all to repent**
- **2 PET 3:9 - God wants all to repent**

(Luke 13:3 KJV) "I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish."

(Acts 17:30 KJV) "And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:"

(2 Pet 3:9 KJV) "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."

CONFESS

- **MT 10:32-33 - Confess before men**
- **ROM 10:10 - Confession is made unto salvation**

(Mat 10:32-33 KJV) "Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. {33} But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven."

(Rom 10:10 KJV) "For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

BE BAPTIZED

- **MEANING - “Immersion”**
- **MK 16:16 - Those baptized = saved**
- **ROM 6:3-4 - Baptism is a burial**
- **ACTS 8:34-39 - Baptized in water**
- **ACTS 2:38; 22:16 - For the forgiveness of sins**
- **1 PET 3:21 - Baptism saves us**

(Mark 16:16 KJV) "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned."

(Rom 6:3-4 KJV) "Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? {4} Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life."

(Acts 8:38 KJV) "And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him."

(Acts 2:38 KJV) "Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost."

(Acts 22:16 KJV) "And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord."

(1 Pet 3:21 KJV) "The like figure whereunto *even* baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:"

AFTER SALVATION

- **ADDED TO THE CHURCH**
 - **ACTS 2:47** - God adds to HIS church
- **STAY FAITHFUL**
 - **Matt 10:22** - Endureth to the end - saved
 - **Jude 1:5-6** - God punishes the unfaithful
 - **Heb 10:26** - Sin willfully = no sacrifice
- **ALL ARE ESSENTIAL TO SALVATION**
 - **Matt 28:18-20** - Observe all commanded

(Acts 2:47 KJV) "Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved."

(Mat 10:22 KJV) "And ye shall be hated of all *men* for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved."

(Jude 1:5-6 KJV) "I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not. {6} And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day."

(Heb 10:26 KJV) "For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,"

(Mat 28:18-20 KJV) "And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. {19} Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: {20} Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto the end of the world. Amen."
